GUIDELINES

We will be opening church back up on Sunday May 31, 2020 at 9:15 A.M. We hope to see you. Here are the guidelines we are requesting everyone to follow. Most of these are temporary in nature and we will advise when anything changes. If you have any questions, please ask. There will be signage throughout the church and on doors to explain the guidelines

Entrances: Please enter through the north entrance (facing Laurel Street) or the south entrance on the backside of the church. There will be someone at the doors to open and close them so you will not have to touch the doors as you enter. If the weather is nice the doors will just be propped open.

Exits: Please use the same north and south entrances when leaving. All entrance/exit doors will be accessible to leave the church in case of an emergency.

Social Distancing: We request that everyone adhere to social distancing. Chairs in the narthex will be spaced out to comply with this. Some rows of pews will be closed. When in the sanctuary please social distance by family.

Face Masks: Face masks will not be required, but if you want to wear one please do. If you want to wear a mask and don't have one, we will have a limited supply on hand to give out.

Sanctuary Doors: The main double doors to enter the sanctuary will be open at all times. Please enter through the double doors. The single door to the sanctuary will be closed and we ask that you do not use that door.

Restrooms: The main restrooms will be open. We ask one person to use them at a time and they will be

sanitized after each use. Please allow us time to sanitize after someone has used them. The restrooms in fellowship hall will be closed.

Exiting Sanctuary: We will dismiss each row, starting from the back and one side at a time. We then ask that you congregate outside and not in the narthex (weather permitting).

There will be a sanitation station in the narthex, and it will have gloves, masks and hand sanitizer.

Your temperature may be taken as you enter the church. This is done without any contact with your skin. We encourage people with the following conditions or symptoms to stay home until these conditions pass:

These conditions include but are not limited to, people with chronic lung disease, serious heart conditions, those who are immunocompromised and those with chronic kidney disease, or liver disease.

If you have been in contact with any individual displaying symptoms of COVID-19 which include but are not limited to, fever, cough, shortness of breath, chills, repeated shaking, muscle pain, headache, sore throat or new loss of taste or smell or other neurological issues.

Thank you for following these guidelines. Our prayer is that this threat will pass soon, and we will once again be able to gather and hug and shake hands and rejoice in the Lord together. Remember these guidelines are temporary in nature and we will update them as we can.
